Tom Lawson is Professor of Modern History at Northumbria University. He has published two books concerned with the history of the Holocaust, *The Church of England and the Holocaust* and *Debates on the Holocaust*. He is also joint editor of the interdisciplinary journal *Holocaust Studies: A Journal of Culture and History* and has published three edited collections too. His most recent book was *The Last Man: A British Genocide in Tasmania* and he is now working on a more general study of Britain and genocide.

Professor Lawson's keynote lecture will be followed by further talks and activities, including a student presentation on contemporary fascism in Britain.
